Who was Saint Angela?

Born between 1470 and 1475 in Desenzano, Italy, Angela Merici was a farm girl. She had at least three brothers and two sisters, some of whom died very young. Angela and her siblings listened intently to their father as he read to them the lives of the saints. Angela aspired to be a saint and spent much time in prayer. While still a teen, or perhaps at the age of 20, Angela had a vision in which she learned that her deceased sister was in heaven and that she herself would found a company of women. On Nov. 25, 1535, she founded the Company of Saint Ursula, known throughout the world today as the Ursuline Sisters. Find out more about Angela at the Y-DOSA meetings!


WHAT CAN I DO?


